1 Introduction and Overview

This Guide documents pricing for SIHI México, S. de R.L. de C.V.'s ("Sprint Mexico") Multiprotocol Label Switching (MPLS) Internet Protocol (IP) Virtual Private Network (VPN) solution.

The Global MPLS VPN service provides customers with a feature rich IP VPN solution enabling any to any intranet connectivity that is highly secure. The customer data is completely separated from any other entity, the service provides a private VPN to interconnect with their sites across the world. In addition, customers can purchase additional services, such as Secure Internet Access with Network-based Firewall, all on the same underlying network infrastructure.

When designing and implementing an MPLS VPN solution, customers can select from a range of configuration and design elements that can be tailored to meet their specific business needs and requirements. These features include, but may not be limited to:

Y *Variety of port speeds*

Sprint Mexico offers a full complement of port speeds for MPLS VPN, including but not limited to: 1M up to possibly 10 Gig Full Ethernet or higher. Higher speeds may also be available depending on location and pending approval of a special customer arrangement and rates.

Y *Additional features and services*

Sprint Mexico offers optional non-regulated features and managed services. These services will be provided over the same port used for site to site intranet communications. Depending on the specific customer solution, additional pricing may apply.

NOTE: The obligation of Sprint Mexico to provide service is dependent upon its ability to procure and maintain facilities, or obtain services from other vendors, which are required to meet the customer's order for service.

Availability of Sprint Mexico Global MPLS VPN Service must be confirmed at the time the order is placed. Service and bandwidth availability can vary within the country.

2 Pricing Components

Pricing components for Sprint Mexico Global MPLS VPN service may consist of a non- recurring charge (NRC) and/or a monthly recurring charge (MRC).

The MPLS VPN pricing components are divided into two categories, standard and optional. The standard components are part of each and every MPLS VPN order. The optional components are additional features and services that may be added to a MPLS VPN order, as described in Section 1.

Standard MPLS VPN pricing components include:

- Local Loop Access
- Transport fees, based on location and speed of the entry port

It is important to note that although there are multiple sub-elements or configurable attributes to a port (i.e. routing protocol, link protocol, VRF, ability to submit change requests) these sub- elements are not individually billed, since they are bundled into the price of the port.

Pricing for standard transport fees is provided here; pricing for the optional services is not included here but can be provided on request.

Please note that the network design includes two administrator accounts (including digital certificates for administrator authentication and security) for the customer to use when communicating service requests (via e-mail) with Sprint Mexico. These secure accounts are required. If customers require more than two administrator accounts, additional charges will apply.

2.1 Pricing Structure – Standard Components

The following sections describe pricing for each standard component of Global MPLS VPN service.

NOTE: In the event of a rate change now or in the future, the customer will be charged the rate agreed to in the customer contract.

2.1.1 Sprint Mexico Provided Local Loop Access

Standard local access may be provided by Sprint Mexico through a licensed local access provider. Customers may also have the option of obtaining local access on their own. Sprint Mexico local access pricing is based on pricing from the underlying local access provider. Local access pricing is not included here but can be provided on request.

2.1.2 Port Charges

Flat rate port pricing is based on speed and location of the entry port. The entry port provides the customer’s physical “gateway” for each site into the MPLS network.

Global MPLS VPN port speeds include 1M up to possibly 10 Gig Full Ethernet or higher which pricing is included here. Pricing for other speeds is available by request.

NOTE: If Sprint Mexico does not have the capability to backhaul over Sprint's own infrastructure, then Backhaul is not included in the Port price and will represent an additional charge to the customer.

Flat rate port charges in Mexico are as indicated below. Port charges consist of a Non-Recurring Charge and a Monthly Recurring Charge.
